Financial Support for families

Mentone Girls' Secondary College understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options, including:

- CSEF Parents with a valid means-tested concession card are eligible for the Victorian Government Camps, Sports, and Excursions Fund, (CSEF). CSEF pays the school \$225 for each eligible secondary school student. This can be used for incursions, excursions, camps, or activities, including Interschools Sport.
 New Families - Please note: If you have been receiving CSEF from a previous school, you will need to fill out a new application for Mentone Girls' Secondary College.
 What you need to do Complete the CSEF application which can be found here https://www2.education.vic.gov.au/pal/camps-sports-and-excursions-fund/guidance/submitting-application
- Make sure that the Surname, First Name, and Customer Reference Number (CRN) details match those on your concession card. Sign and date the form.
- Return the form to the school with a copy of your eligible concession card. Applications close June 2024. Late applications cannot be accepted.
